## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The rose colored vestments today (not pink, mind you) tell us this is *Gaudete* Sunday. This is one of two Sundays featuring the color rose. The other is during Lent known as *Laetare* Sunday. Both are Latin words for “rejoice”. To keep them straight just remember the L-words go together: Lent and *Laetare*.



Joy permeates today's Scriptures. Isaiah tells us, “I rejoice heartily in the Lord, in my God is the joy of my soul.” Saint Paul commands us, “Rejoice always.” The responsorial psalm is not a psalm, but Mary's hymn of praise, the *Magnificat*. We sing with her, “My soul rejoices in my God.”

This might seem a bit excessive to us. It is fair to say that in certain parts of the Church joy is viewed with skepticism, and the manifestation of it is suspect. All too often Catholics fit the description of God's Frozen Chosen.

Pope Francis famously said, Christians must not look like they are always coming from a funeral. Yes, joy is not simply an emotion but it should make us different inside and out. If we are indeed joyful followers of Christ, our lives must reflect that reality. *Gaudete* Sunday requires us to throw decorum to the wind and rejoice in God's goodness.

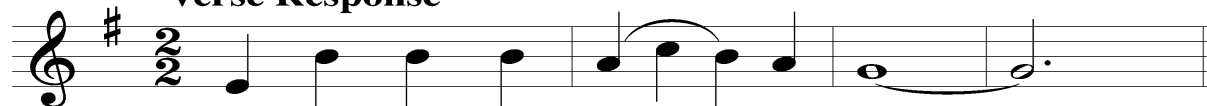

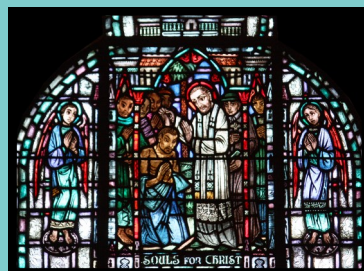

This will be the final week for books and spirituality materials this year. Come down to the Lower Hall on Sunday morning and find something to enrich your spirit in the New Year.

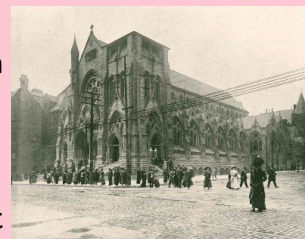

## OPENINGS ON THE SFX PASTORAL COUNCIL:

The St. Francis Xavier (College) Church Pastoral Council is a group composed of the pastor and twelve active, adult parishioners who meet regularly to deliberate, reflect, and make decisions on a variety of issues related to the operations, programming, and spiritual life of the parish. The Pastoral Council provides support and direction to the various parish Commissions and Committees, and is generally charged with making sure that all activities support the parish's Mission. There will be at least two openings on the Pastoral Council starting in January 2018. Council members serve for a three-year term with the option to serve a second term. The group meets one Saturday morning per month, and also participates actively in various special events throughout the year. A parishioner may nominate another parishioner, or nominate himself/herself.

Nominees will be asked to submit a short statement explaining their interest in serving on the Council answering the following three questions: (1) What has drawn you to SFX College Church, and what are your hopes for the future of the parish? (2) What background and experience, either professional, personal, or as a parishioner, would you bring to the Council and how would you apply it? (3) Can you commit to regular attendance and participation at Council meetings and, from time to time, assisting with special projects or events?

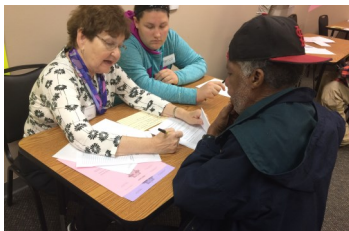
We are especially interested in people who are interested in our four current goals (summarized here):
