#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



This past Monday two young men were shot and killed right in front of College Church. The number of people murdered in St. Louis in 2020 stands at 125. The total at this time last year was 99. I suspect by the end of 2020 the city of St. Louis will have more murders than deaths due to Covid-19.

Let me suggest these two calamities have something in common. They both expose the incredible gaps that exist in our society that enables them to be so deadly. Violence in our city is exacerbated by poverty, lack of opportunity, the proliferation of guns, unemployment, and on and on. They each reflect that certain members of society are worthy of attention and investment, while others are not. Concern over the coronavirus and violence is quite limited if it seems that it has little impact on me and those I love.

Such a complex problem will require a multitude of solutions. I wish that if we just did one thing all of this would disappear. But we cannot afford wishful thinking. This will require a commitment to working on all the varied factors that will alleviate violence. Our faith calls us to engagement especially in difficult times. May God give us the grace to do so.

#### Bridges Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius in Everyday Life

#### **Bishops Endorse Medicaid Expansion**

Saying "Yes on 2" for the August 4<sup>th</sup> primary election ballot to expand Medicaid, providing healthcare to the most vulnerable citizens in our midst, will give Catholics an opportunity to live out their Catholic social teaching beliefs. That is the essence of a letter signed by the state's four bishops that was issued late last January. The letter speaks out for poor Missourians that include the elderly, the disabled, pregnant women and children.

As it is, Missouri taxpayer money goes to Washington, D.C., to fund healthcare for 36 other states including New York and California. "In our Catholic ministries throughout the state...we find that there are still many Missouri citizens who lack access to affordable healthcare coverage that is so necessary for human flourishing," the bishops contended.



Additionally, the letter indicates that Medicaid expansion is all about saving lives and is pro-life. "Our commitment to life is unwavering and lives are at stake," the bishops wrote. "We must make decisions on what we currently know to be true."

Medicaid Expansion is a racial justice issue as well!

## Parish Immersion Trip to El Paso, TX: Thursday 10/22/20-Tuesday 10/27/20

College Church still has plans for a border immersion trip to El Paso, Texas and Juarez, Mexico with the Jesuit ministry 'Encuentro Project' in October 2020. The purpose will be to facilitate learning and awareness about immigration through direct experience, with

a goal of then taking action for immigration justice. The trip has a capacity of 14 people (adults only). All trip participants MUST have a valid passport. The total cost of the trip is expected to be approximately \$850 per individual.

#### **Examples of Potential Activities:**

- Meeting parishioners and staff of El Sagrado Corazon (Sacred Heart), a Jesuit parish founded in 1893, located 3 blocks from the Texas/Mexico border. Visit participants and instructors in Social Ministries adult education program. Participate in Sunday liturgy.
- Border Patrol's information tour.
- Diocese's office for immigration legal assistance (DMRS) overview presentation of immigration law.
- Mass with detainees at ICE Detention Center in El Paso. Meet detainees.
- Visiting Annunciation House, a hospitality house for migrants and refugees.
- Presentation on border environmental concerns, given by university professor from Cd. Juarez.
- Programs for the impoverished in Cd. Juarez, Mexico. Meet the people and the leaders (a passport is required); or other U.S. option.
- Eucharists and end-of-day reflections. Common meals in the evening.
