**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

This Saturday, August 15<sup>th</sup> two Jesuits will be ordained to the priesthood at College Church. The ordination, like so many other events, was delayed due to COVID-19. One of the new priests is Matt Stewart who will begin as our associate pastor about 48 hours after his ordination. Nothing like jumping in with both feet.

There are a multitude of theologies and spiritualities of the priesthood. I believe it best viewed in the same way as our faith tradition. Tradition seeks to engage the needs of God's people in specific times and places. Tradition also acknowledges the equally important need to remain rooted in the wisdom that has come before. Authentic tradition lives in the balance.

A priest shares that task. He must discern how to creatively engage the moment while not wandering from a solid foundation. It is like the scribe in Matthew's Gospel who, having been schooled in the Kingdom of Heaven, "brings from the storeroom both new and old." Clearly, this is only possible by the grace of God.

The best advice I ever received regarding priesthood came from my novice director. He told us simply, *the people will teach you how to be a priest*. Amen to that. I am certain you will be good and wise teachers for Fr. Matt as you have for all our new priests at SFX. And please don't neglect the senior priest here. He still has a lot to learn, too.

Next Sunday, August 16, we will livestream the 8:00 am Mass, as it will be the first Mass for Fr. David Lugo, SJ. This Mass will be in English and Spanish. The livestream Mass will return to 10:30 am the following Sunday, August 23rd.

Beginning August 17th, we will have three Masses Monday through Friday: 7:15 am, noon, and 5:15 pm. They will be held in the main church.

Dear Parishioners,

I would like to update you on some re-structuring within the parish staff. The changes reflect a desire to have a stable, sustainable staff to accomplish our mission now and for the next three years. I have tried to structure a staff that can achieve the needs of the present while taking into account where we see ourselves in the near future. Sr. Carolyn McWatters will serve as our Coordinator of Liturgy. This position will facilitate our weekend liturgical celebrations. Sue Martin and Ray Sherrock will coordinate our music ministry. I believe this will allow us to continue to our long history of excellent and prayerful liturgies.

The staff has also made a generous decision in response to our challenging budget. All members of the staff will take a week's unpaid furlough during the fall semester. This will be a great help for us to make our financial goals this year. I am most grateful for their willingness to make this sacrifice.

The incredible staff we have is essential to the good work we do as a parish. I have sought to balance our future needs, the integrity of my team and the hard reality of a difficult fiscal year. I am confident we will continue to thrive due to the dedicated staff we enjoy at College Church. Thank you for your continued support.

### **Our New Associate Pastor will join us August 17th**



Matthew C. Stewart, SJ, was born and raised in St. Louis, Missouri, by his two wonderful parents alongside his younger brother. He met the Jesuits while as a student at St. Louis University High School. He attended Saint Louis University. After college, he joined the Alum Service Corps (ASC) and taught theology and music at Rockhurst High School in Kansas City, Missouri. After this volunteer year, Matt was hired back at his alma mater, SLUH, where he taught for six years prior to entering the Society. Matt did his novitiate in Grand Coteau, Louisiana under the expert guidance of Fr. Dan White, SJ. Matt went to Denver to pursue a degree in choral conducting at the University of Denver while doing his regency at Regis University. While there, he taught theology, supervised the Peer Ministry program and coordinated liturgy alongside his colleagues in university ministry. Matt earned his Licentiate in Sacred Theology at the Boston College School of Theology and Ministry focusing on liturgical theology.

## Our Parish Vision

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I hope that you have been following the video communications related to Our Parish Vision. Thank you to the heads of commissions and members of the pastoral council who have participated. They are YouTube's newest stars!

The videos serve as an introduction to our present and point to where we are headed in the next five years. I wanted to share with you some thoughts on Our Parish Vision and parish leadership. That relationship is essential because our mission shapes, and is in turn shaped, by the exercise of leadership at College Church. This is the first in a series I want to do over the next few weeks.

I am always a fan of providing a bit of context. SFX has a lot of it given that we have been around for nearly 180 years. Leadership has been a bit more complicated than you might expect. You can see these distinctive elements have shaped us. We have been blessed with many wonderful pastors over these long years on whose shoulders I stand. I would add we have enjoyed from the very beginning strong guidance from parishioners. Working together has been a hallmark of College Church for many years. I personally have benefitted from an excellent pastoral council, finance committee, commissions, and an incredible staff.

This great gift has enabled the flourishing of our faith community. One of the distinguishing characteristics of SFX is not only are you invested and committed to this place, but that you truly see it as your own. Many parishioners over long years have contributed to the flourishing of our spiritual home. We have a tremendous history of responsibility and care for the gifts the Holy Spirit has entrusted to us. ### Purchase Fair Trade Products and Support our Sister Parish

Until further notice, sales of fair trade products are resuming **online only** to benefit our sister Jesuit parish St. Peter Claver in Belize. Because of the pandemic, as well as a series of fires which destroyed farms in the St. Peter Claver parish community, unemployment in Punta Gorda, where the parish located, has increased dramatically. In response, St. Peter Claver is opening a food bank, which we would like to support through our fair trade sales.

Hand Delivery (only for orders of \$20 or more): One of our volunteers will deliver your products to your porch or in front of your home. If requesting delivery of orders which contain chocolate, please plan for immediate retrieval of your package in order to protect chocolate from melting. Volunteers will ring your doorbell/buzzer or knock on your door when dropping off items.

Pick-up at College Church (orders of any value): Pick-ups at the College Church will be pre-collected into bags with the buyer's name displayed on the outside of the bag, available from 9-10:15am outside of the Ballroom (below the church) on the designated Sundays. We ask that parishioners wear a face mask and continue to practice social distancing during pick-up.

This Sunday marks the anniversary of the death of Michael Brown.
